Interpretation

Data: All information that you submit to Martistry Limited via the website.

Cookies: A small text file placed on your computer by this website, or third-party providers used by this website. Details and purposes of the Cookies used by this website are listed below.

Data Protection Laws: Any applicable law relating to the processing of personal data, including but not limited to the General Data Protection Regulations, and any national implementing laws, regulations, and secondary legislation.

Scope of this Policy

Data Collected

The data we collect is either given to us by you or is collected automatically.

Automatically Collected Data

Our Use of Data

Data Retention

Unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law, we will only hold your data on our systems for the period necessary to fulfil the purposes outlined in this privacy policy or until you request that the data be deleted. Even if we delete your data, it may persist on backup or archival media for legal, tax or regulatory purposes.

Sharing Data

We may share your data with the following groups of people for the following reasons: third party service providers who provide services to us which require the processing of personal data in order to improve your experience of this website; third party payment providers who process payments made over the website – in order to fulfil transactions and purchases; regulatory authorities, courts, tribunals, government agencies and law enforcement agencies. While it is unlikely, we may be required to disclose your information to comply with legal or regulatory requirements. We will use reasonable endeavours to notify you before we do this unless we are legally restricted from doing so; in each case, in accordance with this privacy policy.

Data Security

We will use technical and organisational measures to safeguard your data.

We store your data on secure servers.

Your Rights
